## 2021 Moon of the Month

**Anishinaabe:** Spirit Moon (Mnido Giizis)- It is manifested through the northern lights. It is a time to honour the silence and realize our place within all Great Mystery's creatures.

Cree: Frost Exploding Moon (Opawahcikanasis)- Trees crackle from cold temperatures and extreme cold starts.

**Inuit:** Great Plain Moon (Taqqiinnarjuak)- Inuit people paid special attention to this month from other months at a time when Inuit were still practicing aglirnik (refraining from doing certain things). Aglirnik lasted for a month, particularly women, for example refraining from cracking caribou marrow bone, to protect from falling into misfortune.

**Haudenosaunee:** Midwinter Festival (Sha'tekohshérhon).

Algonquin: (Squochee Kesos)- Sun has not strength to thaw.
