#### 2021 Flower Moon

**Anishinaabe:** Flower Moon (Waawaaskone Giizis)- The fifth moon of Creation is Flower Moon, where all plants display their Spirit sides for all the world to see. This life giving energy is one of the most powerful healing medicines on Mother Earth. During this month we are encouraged to explore our Spiritual Essences.

**Cree:** Frog Moon (Athikipisim)- Arrival of warm weather and open water. Frogs begin to become active in ponds and swamps.

**Inuit:** Pregnant Caribou Moon (Ivlauliit)- Spring time is the season in which caribou give birth to their fawns and this month represents pregnant caribous' birthing activity.

Haudenosaunee: (Latiy\u00e1thos)- Planting.

**Algonquin:** (Moonesquanimock kesos)- When women weed corn.
